Dear Parent/Carer,

HEALTH & SAFETY: During the warmer weather, we would ask you to provide your child with a summer hat to wear while playing outside, in order to prevent sunburn. We have school caps on sale if you don't have one. You may also choose to apply sunscreen before your child comes into school. The children will still play outside during the warmer weather.

If this person is not known to us, we will need confirmation before they will be allowed to take your child.
