Year 2 Great Fire of London – Workshop and Tour: PRE-BOOKING OFFER

As part of our History topic next term, Year 2 are taking part in two very exciting events:

- a) **A workshop in school** on 13th March held by the Epping Forest District Museum giving the children the opportunity to find out more about the Great Fire of London.
- b) **A Great Fire of London Trip**, which will visit the City of London visiting St Olave's Church (where Samuel Pepys worshipped and is buried) the Monument, the Guildhall, St Pauls Cathedral and the statue marking the place where the fire ended. We will also see other London sights – the Bank of England, Tower of London, London Eye and the Shard. We will be going as follows: -

- **Classes 2H & 2P – Thursday 22nd March**
- **Classes 2D & 2C – Friday 23rd March**

The total cost will be £9.90 per child which includes coach fares, the cost of the workshops as well as a poncho each in case of rain on the day of the trip. Please pay via parentpay by 9th March and ensure you grant permission online for your child.

As all children in Year 2 are entitled to a free school packed lunch for this trip, lunch will be provided for your child, so you are NOT required to provide a packed lunch. We would ask that you send in an empty carrier bag for your child to carry their lunch in as the paper bags provided may tear.
