**ADVANCED NOTICE – SEPTEMBER PRICE INCREASES:** In line with our increased costs we have been forced to raise our prices from 5<sup>th</sup> September, as follows:

- School meals - £11.50 per child per week – i.e. £2.30 per day
- Breakfast Club - £10.00 per child per week – i.e. £2.00 per day

These prices still offer your child a nutritional meal as a reasonable rate. Please adjust your parentpay payments as necessary nearer the time.
