FRIENDS OF WILBURY SUMMER FAIR: This year's fair will be held this **Thursday 5th July** and we do hope to see you there from 3.15 – 5.00 p.m. We will also hold the grand opening of our new outdoor classroom at that time and hope you will take the opportunity to see it. Other attractions will be inflatables, mini-fairground rides, stalls, face-painting, refreshments and a BBQ as well as other fun and games.

Raffle tickets have now been sent home to you - £1 each - £100 shopping vouchers main prize - the draw will be held at 4.30 pm at the fair.

WHOLE SCHOOL CELEBRATION: This year's celebration on the school field will be held next week - on **Tuesday 10th July** - and the theme will be 'WATER' supporting our nominated charities of WATER AID and NOAH'S ARK Children's Hospice. SEPTEMBER PRICE INCREASES: In line with our increased costs we have been forced to raise our prices from 5th September, as follows:

- School meals - £11.50 per child per week – i.e. £2.30 per day
- Breakfast Club - £10.00 per child per week – i.e. £2.00 per day

These prices still offer your child a nutritional meal at a reasonable rate. Please adjust your parentpay payments as necessary nearer the time

HEALTH & SAFETY: During the warmer weather, we would ask you to provide your child with a sun hat to wear while playing outside, in order to prevent sunburn. We have school caps on sale if you don't have one. You may also choose to apply sunscreen before your child comes into school. The children will still play outside during the warmer weather.



SCHOOL UNIFORM: Please remember that uniform is available to purchase via the link on our website and can be collected directly from the school office or our suppliers on www.mapac.com. Any orders over £50 will not be charged postage. Uniform pre-order during the summer break will be available for collection from the school office between **9.30 and 12 noon on Tuesday 4th September.**
