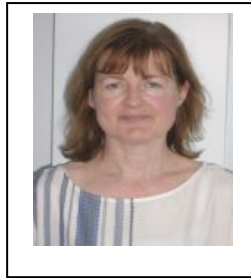
STAFF: I am pleased to say that we are fully staffed for the new year and would like to welcome our new teachers and other staff to Wilbury.

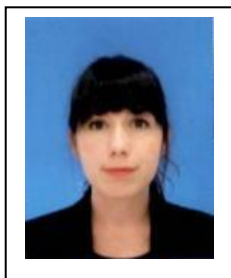

SEPTEMBER PRICE INCREASES: In line with our increased costs we have been forced to raise our prices from 5th September, as follows:

- School meals - £11.50 per child per week – i.e. £2.30 per day
- Breakfast Club - £10.00 per child per week – i.e. £2.00 per day

These prices still offer your child a nutritional meal at a reasonable rate.

Please adjust your parentpay payments as necessary nearer the time
