HEALTH & SAFETY: During the warmer weather, we would ask you to provide your child with a summer hat to wear while playing outside, in order to prevent sunburn. We have school caps on sale if you don't have one. You may also choose to apply sunscreen before your child comes into school. The children will still play outside during the warmer weather.



PHOTOGRAPHS: The photographer will be in school on Tuesday 11th June, taking photos of class groups. These will be sent home within 10 days – if you wish to purchase please return with the correct payment by the date shown.

These orders are then collected directly by the photographers - the payments are not dealt with by the school.

EVENT INVITATIONS: As we are now approaching the busiest time of our year for assemblies, concerts and plays, we would ask all parents to wait at the **yellow gates** until opened at the allocated arrival time. Please do not enter via the office as the foyer becomes overcrowded creating a hazard for children trying to enter the school.

KITCHEN INSPECTION : Our kitchen was inspected at the end of May, by the LA in a random check and awarded 5 stars, the highest rate for cleanliness and hygiene.

SUMMER HOLIDAYS: The last day of Summer Term for Wilbury students is **Friday 19th July, 2019**. Please ensure that you book any travel arrangements **after** 19th July, 2019. We do not expect any children to leave for holiday before this date. The first day of term for pupils will be Wednesday 4th September 2019 and we expect all pupils to attend on this date.

You should be aware that if you take your child on holiday during term time, without authorisation, you may be liable to incur a Penalty Notice which will be applied by the school and issued by the Local Authority. School reopens on **Wednesday 4th September** after two training days for teachers earlier in the week.
