We were incredibly proud of our end of KS results in phonics, reading, writing and maths. Nearly all of our results were above national and many significantly above! I am proud to say, there is a collective responsibility amongst all our staff for raising standards and addressing educational disadvantage and this is what makes the difference here!

As Headteacher, I was asked to speak to Headteachers and other senior leaders across the country in a joint Department for Education (DfE) & Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) webinar about our whole school approach to addressing disadvantage. We also have lots of schools and other organisations who visit Wilbury and Mrs Sovaros (KS1 Head of Department) is currently sharing our excellent reading programme with our Trust schools and other local Haringey and Enfield schools.



Wilbury is an Early Excellence Partner school and we are very proud of our 'Outstanding' Early Years provision. Mrs Chaloner (DHT) leads on Early Years at Wilbury and across the Trust and she works very closely with Early Excellence to provide exceptional training for staff at all levels. Wilbury hosted a very well attended training roadshow for staff across the local area in early November. Mrs Chaloner and Mrs Sengonul (Science Lead) also took part in a podcast for Early Excellence about high quality leadership and science in the Early Years.
