Rosa Parks

We want to talk about & raise the profile of online safety so we asked the children at Wilbury about their online usage.

This is what we found out:

- **28%** in Y5 & Y6 spend more than 4 hours online after school!
- **56%** of pupils in Y5 & Y6 have been on sites that are not allowed. This was **50%** in Y3 & Y4 and **24.5%** in Y1 & Y2.
- **77%** of Y5 & Y6 pupils could use privacy settings compared to only **31%** of Y3 & Y4 – **this is a worry!**
- 2/3 of children said they are supervised by their parents when online.
- **Worryingly** some children do talk to strangers online, have arguments online, play games or watch films aimed at older children, and make accounts for TIK TOK without parental consent.

What are we going to do:

- **Initiate discussions & talk time**
- **Consider if visual prompts, assemblies or weekly reminders will help**
