STAFF TRAINING: We will be holding an in-school all staff training session this **Friday 19th April from 1.00 pm** – **SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED** – so please arrange to collect your child at that time from the usual exit. Nursery afternoon classes will be closed and there will not be any after school club on that day. Lunch will be served in school slightly earlier so all children are ready to leave at <u>1.00 pm</u>

LATYMER SCHOOL OPEN DAY: 25th April 2024, 12pm-

TWO YEAR OLD PROVISION: The eligibility rules have now changed to extend to families where both parents are working. If you feel you may be eligible please contact the school office for further details. This would cover 15 hours per week/ 38 weeks term time – 3 hours per day over five days.

TERRIFIC TWOS – paid places: We are able to offer places in TWOS at £20 per session for parents who are not eligible for funding. This would be for up to five 3-hour sessions per week, mornings or afternoons during term time. Please contact our school office if you are interested.

COMIC RELIEF/RED NOSE DAY: Friday 15th March – thank you to everyone who donated to Comic Relief – we raised **£433** which has now been sent on to them.

SCHOOL UNIFORM: If you are considering buying summer dresses for school please remember these should be <u>blue</u> and are available from supermarkets or online from Mapac.com and once ordered will be delivered directly to the school. They also supply school cardigans. All other uniform is available to order via our website and once paid for can be collected from the office the following day.

ATTENDANCE: We would like all parents to know that our target for school attendance remains at **96%**. Please report your child's absence from school before **9.30am** by telephoning 020 88075335 (Select Option 1 for Attendance) and advise us of the reason for your child's absence. **Please see our website for a list of the school holidays – please book any summer holidays within these dates and <u>not</u> during term time.**

SCHOOL LUNCHES: If your child changes from packed lunch to school meals and has any special requests - ie vegetarian/no dairy - please remember to mention to the office or to the class teacher on the first day in order to avoid any confusion.

SCHOOL MEALS & HOME PACKED LUNCHES: Please see our packed lunch policy and updated menus on our website. Please also bear in mind that the school receives additional funding if our uptake of school meals is over 90%. Please call the office if you would like to change to free school meals – saving you over £400 per year per child.

HEADLICE: If you think your child may be suffering from headlice please ask your pharmacist for advice or access the NHS website/headlice for information.

NUT ALLEGIES: We are a healthy eating school and several of our children have severe nut allergies. Please **DO NOT** send any child into school with nut products (peanut butter, nutella etc) or chocolates or biscuits and cakes containing nuts in their lunch boxes. Even the smell of these products can cause an allergic reaction to another child sitting nearby.

WATER BOTTLES: Please remember to send your child to school with a **plastic water** bottle showing their name – not a metal bottle.

KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE: ROAD SAFETY & Parking in Wilbury Way/Weir Hall Road: Please remember that road safety is the responsibility of <u>everyone</u> and we must ensure all our children are safe at all times. Please remember to park sensibly outside our school for the safety of all our children and **DO NOT** stop on the mini roundabout to drop off your child as this is extremely dangerous. In consideration of our neighbours, please do not park across their driveways whether the car is there or not. If they have a dropped kerb you could be fined up to £250 if traffic wardens are in attendance and it is towed. **Please keep well away from the bus stop area as this is very dangerous for children boarding or leaving the buses.**
