Dear Parent/Carer,

HOLIDAYS: Please note that we close on **Friday 18th July** for the summer and reopen to children on **Wednesday 3rd September**. Please ensure your child attends and that all holidays you book are between these dates.

Please see our website for a list of all the school holidays – please book any holidays within these dates and not during term time.



PHOTOGRAPHER: The photographers will be here on **Wednesday 11th June** to photograph the children in their current classes – your child will be provided with the online log-in details for their class photo on the day. You will then be able to log-on, view the photo and place your orders online.

BAG-2-SCHOOL – Thank you to everyone who donated to the Bag-2-school appeal last month.

PUNCTUALITY & ATTENDANCE: **Please make sure you bring your children to school on time every day**, we don't want them to miss out on any valuable learning time! Your most important job as a parent is to bring them to school on time every day and, in school, we will help your children to thrive and achieve!

NUT ALLERGIES: We are a healthy eating school and several of our children have severe nut allergies. Please **DO NOT** send any child into school with nut products (peanut butter, sesame seeds, nutella etc) or chocolates or biscuits and cakes containing nuts in their lunch boxes. Even the smell of these products can cause an allergic reaction to another child sitting nearby

TWO YEAR OLD PROVISION: The eligibility rules have changed to extend to families where both parents are working. If you feel you may be eligible please contact the school office for further details. This would cover 15 hours per week/38 weeks term time – 3 hours per day over five days. We are able also to offer places in TWOS at £20 per session for parents who are not eligible for funding. This would be for up to five 3-hour sessions per week, mornings or afternoons during term time. Please contact our school office if you are interested.

SCHOOL MEALS & HOME PACKED LUNCHES: Please see our packed lunch policy and updated summer term menus on our website. Please also bear in mind that the school receives additional funding if our uptake of school meals is over 90%. Please call the office if you would like to change to free school meals – saving you over £400 per year per child.

KS1 BOOK SWAP – 16th June: We are holding a book swap for Years 1 and 2 on Monday 16th June – more details to follow this week.

CELEBRATION DAY: We are planning our annual celebration day on the morning of **Monday 14th July** – so please put this in your diary as we would welcome you all to join us to celebrate on the field. Further details will follow.

SECURITY LOCKS: Please remember that if you are leaving your child's bike on site during the day they **must** be securely locked while on the bike ramps. Please provide a lock and ensure your child knows how to use it.

HEALTH & SAFETY: During the warmer weather, we would ask you to provide your child with a summer hat to wear while playing outside, in order to prevent sunburn. School caps are on sale via MAPAC if you don't have one. You may also choose to apply sunscreen before your child comes into school. The children will still play outside during the warmer weather. If your child suffers from hayfever please give their medication before they come in. Please also provide a plastic bottle of water with their name on it – not a metal bottle.



HEADLICE/RING WORM: If you think your child may be suffering from headlice or ringworm please ask your pharmacist for advice or access the NHS website for information. All children must be treated before they return to school.

KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE: ROAD SAFETY & Parking in Wilbury Way/ Weir Hall Road: Please remember that road safety is the responsibility of everyone and we must ensure all our children are safe at all times. **Please remember to park sensibly outside our school for the safety of all our children and DO NOT stop on the mini roundabout to drop off your child as this is extremely dangerous.** In consideration of our neighbours, please do not park across their driveways whether the car is there or not. If they have a dropped kerb you could be fined up to £250 if traffic wardens are in attendance and it is towed. **Always ensure you are never blocking emergency vehicle access.** Please keep well away from the bus stop area as this is very dangerous for children boarding or leaving the buses.

SCHOOL UNIFORM: in line with the other schools in our Trust, we have now transferred all our uniform sales to MAPAC the uniform providers. You can still place online orders which can either be delivered directly to your home address incurring a postage charge or have it delivered to the school without a postal charge. Deliveries are likely to be every two weeks so please bear this in mind when placing your orders.
