Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to our final half term of this year - we have a very busy month coming up in school so please check the website, the list overleaf and your emails for updates so you don't miss out on any of the activities.

MRS SARAH COBOURNE: We will be holding a tribute to Mrs Cobourne on **Monday 6th July at 9.15 a.m.** on the field for about an hour – all welcome. There will be staff tributes, a dedication and songs and dances and contributions from the children. We hope you can attend.



PHOTOGRAPHER: The photographers will be here on **Wednesday 10th June** to photograph the children in their current classes – your child will be provided with the online log-in details for their class photo on the day. You will then be able to log-on, view the photo and place your orders online. We will advise you once this is live.

WINDOW REPLACEMENTS: As I am sure you will have noticed, we are in the process of having our main building windows and doors replaced. This is a huge project – managed by Mustafa – and is due to be completed in the next couple of weeks. We apologise for any inconvenience but the results will be amazing and well worth it.

SUMMER UNIFORM: If you are buying summer dresses this term please note these must be blue for school – they are available from supermarkets or from our uniform providers – www.mapac.com. You can place online orders which can either be delivered directly to your home address incurring a postage charge or have it delivered to the school without a postal charge. Delivery is free for orders over £60. Deliveries are likely to be every two weeks so please bear this in mind when placing your orders. The complete range of uniform is available from MAPAC and is shown on their website – www.mapac.com/education/parents. To ensure your online order is delivered for September please order by 31st July.

HOLIDAYS: Please note that we close on **Friday 17th July** for the summer and school re-opens to children on **Monday 7th September**, after three inset/staff training days on Wednesday Thursday and Friday, 2nd, 3rd and 4th September. Please ensure your child attends and that all holidays you book are between these dates. **ALL CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND ON 7TH SEPTEMBER.** Please see our website for a list of all the school holidays – please book any holidays within these dates and not during term time.

CELEBRATION DAY: We are planning our annual celebration day on the morning of **Monday 13th July** – so please put this in your diary as we would welcome you all to join us to celebrate on the field. Further details will follow.

SPORTSDAYS: Sportsdays are being held early in July – we will provide you with details as soon as these are available. **ALL WELCOME**

KINSHIP: Your child and the school may be entitled to additional funding if they are not living with their parents for a period of time. Please contact the school if this applies to you and we are not yet aware of this arrangement.

R E M I N D E R S :

STARTING SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2026: If you have a child – or are aware of friends or family's children – who are ready to start nursery or reception in September 2026 please ensure they have registered. If not please contact the school office or Enfield Council directly to register them as soon as possible.

ATTENDANCE: Please report your child's absence from school before **9.30am** by telephoning 020 88075335 (**Select Option 1 for Attendance**) and advise us of the reason for your child's absence. Please give your child's full name and class each time. We would like all parents to know that our target for school attendance remains at **96%**.

NUTS & ALLERGIES: We are a healthy eating school and several of our children have severe nut allergies. Please **DO NOT** send any child into school with nut products (peanut butter, sesame seeds, nutella etc) or chocolates or biscuits and cakes containing nuts in their lunch boxes. Even the smell of these products can cause an allergic reaction to another child sitting nearby.

WATER BOTTLES: Please remember to send your child to school with a **plastic water** bottle showing their name.

KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE: Please **DO NOT** park in the staff carparks – particularly beside the kitchen – as this creates an obstruction. We have had deliveries refused as the drivers were unable to enter the premises. Please park in the surrounding streets outside of the school streets scheme – see below.

ROAD SAFETY & Parking in Wilbury Way/Weir Hall Road: Please remember that road safety is the responsibility of everyone and we must ensure all our children are safe at all times. Please remember to park sensibly outside our school for the safety of all our children and **DO NOT** stop on the mini roundabout to drop off your child as this is extremely dangerous. In consideration of our neighbours, please do not park across their driveways whether the car is there or not. If they have a dropped kerb you could be fined up to £250 if traffic wardens are in attendance and it is towed. **Always ensure you are never blocking emergency vehicle access.** Please keep well away from the bus stop area as this is very dangerous for children boarding or leaving the buses.
