As we rapidly approach Christmas, we are extremely busy with shows, pantomimes, concerts and parties, so please check the website regularly for updates, times and information – **www.wilburyprimaryschool.org.uk :** What's Happening? Everybody is welcome to attend the shows and concerts – we will be holding <u>cash</u> collections after each performance for **FRIENDS OF WILBURY**. We are all delighted to be able to participate again this year after the past two years absence and look forward to welcoming you into school.

SCHOOL CLOSED: Please note the next inset staff training day – **Tuesday 3rd January**, so school will be **<u>CLOSED</u>** – reopens Wednesday 4th January, 2023.

CHRISTMAS LUNCH: Christmas lunch will be served on **Friday 9th December**. If your child already receives a school meal, you **<u>do not</u>** need to do anything on



this occasion. Children who currently have a **home packed lunch** can choose to have a school meal on this day and pay £2.30 via parentpay by 6^{th} December. There will be a vegetarian option available. Children are welcome to wear a **Christmas jumper** on this day, but

please ensure the rest of their uniform is still worn.

PHOTOGRAPHS: The orders are now being printed and will be sent home to you as soon as they are received.

LOST PROPERTY: Lost property will be on display on **Tuesday 13th December**, in the Dining Hall from 3.15 p.m.—so if your child has lost an item of clothing in the past term, please come and have a look. <u>All items will then be disposed of</u>. **PLEASE ENSURE ALL YOUR CHLD'S CLOTHES ARE NAMED.**

ENERGY COSTS - REMINDER: We would ask you to please ensure your child comes to school dressed in layers of clothes to ensure they are kept warm on the coldest days. School fleeces are available and are particularly warm both at school and at home. Our energy budgets are constantly reviewed but are understandably under extreme pressure at the moment – please rest assured the school will be heated as necessary.

SCHOOL STREETS: Please be aware that our school has now been activated as part of the scheme - this means you cannot drive through Weir Hall Road at set times of the day when children are arriving and leaving the premises. **(08.30 – 9.15 am and 2.45 – 3.30 p.m.).** Cameras will be operating and fines of up to £120 will be issued by the council. The area included from be between Wilbury Way and Lansbury Avenue – the road will not be blocked but the cameras will be recording. Please understand this is a council-run operation and has nothing to do with the school – we cannot enter into disputes regarding fines.

CHRISTMAS PARTIES: We are delighted to be able to hold parties again for the children this year – the dates for each year group are shown overleaf. Please send in **one item** of party food on the appropriate day for your child to share with the class. They may bring party clothes to change into for the celebration.

BULGARIAN SURGERY: Our Bulgarian family support worker will be available in the office each <u>Thursday</u> from 2.30 pm to assist any parents with any queries.

TERRIFIC TWOS – paid places: We are able to offer places in TWOS at £20 per session for parents who are not eligible for funding. This would be for five 3-hour sessions per week, term time. Please contact our school office if you are interested.
