Welcome back to the final half term of our year. We have lots of events planned so please check the website for the latest updates.

OFSTED: We are very proud to advise you that our recent OFSTED report is now available – if you missed the copy we emailed to you the full version is on our website. We would like to thank everyone who contributed towards this superb outcome.



PHOTOGRAPHER: The photographers will be here on **Tuesday 6th June** to photograph the children in their current Classes – your child will be provided with the online log-in details for their class photo on the day. You will then be able to log-on instantly, view the photo and place your orders online.

KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE: ROAD SAFETY & Parking in Wilbury Way/Weir Hall Road: Please keep well away from the bus stop area as this is very dangerous for children boarding or leaving the buses.

Please remember that road safety is the responsibility of everyone and we must ensure all our children are safe at all times. Please remember to park sensibly outside our school for the safety of all our children and **DO NOT** stop on the mini roundabout to drop off your child as this is extremely dangerous. In consideration of our neighbours, please do not park across their driveways whether the car is there or not. If they have a dropped kerb you could be fined up to £250 if traffic wardens are in attendance and it is towed.

PROPERTY IN SCHOOL: Please be aware that we cannot accept any responsibility for children's property left on school premises. If your child leaves a bike or a scooter in the racks in school you <u>must</u> provide a secure lock for it. Some have gone missing lately which is very upsetting for the children. If possible please add their name in permanent ink underneath the seat.

HOLIDAYS: Please note that we close on **Friday 21st July** for the summer and reopen to children on **Tuesday 5th September.** Please ensure your child attends and that any holidays you book are between these dates.

CELEBRATION DAY: We are planning to hold our Celebration Day this year on **Tuesday 18th July** during the afternoon and we hope parents and carers will be able to join us on the school field to celebrate the 70th anniversary of Wilbury School. It will be lovely to see you all here and to have something to celebrate!

SPORTSDAYS: Sportsdays are being held early in July – we will provide you with details as soon as these are available.

HEALTH & SAFETY: During the warmer weather, we would ask you to provide your child with a summer hat to wear while playing outside, in order prevent sunburn. We have school caps on sale if you don't have one. You may also choose to apply sunscreen before your child comes into school. The children will still play outside during the warmer weather. If your child suffers from hayfever please give their medication before they come in. Please also provide a bottle of water with their name on it.

SCHOOL UNIFORM: If you are considering buying summer dresses for school please remember these should be <u>blue</u> and are available online from Mapac.com and once ordered will be delivered directly to the school. Dresses can also be bought from local supermarkets or uniform suppliers. Mapac also supply school cardigans.

All other uniform is available to order via our website and once paid for via parentpay can be collected from the office the following day.

TERRIFIC TWOS – paid places: We are able to offer places in TWOS at £20 per session for parents who are not eligible for funding. This would be for five 3-hour sessions per week, mornings or afternoons during term time.

REMINDERS:

NUT ALLERGIES: We are a healthy eating school and several of our children have severe nut allergies. Please **DO NOT** send any child into school with nut products (peanut butter, nutella etc) or chocolates or biscuits and cakes containing nuts in their lunch boxes. Even the smell of these products can cause an allergic reaction to another child sitting nearby. **Several children have been bringing in Nutella sandwiches recently – we must ask you not to send any nut products into school.**

- **BULGARIAN SURGERY:** Our Bulgarian family support worker will be available in the office each <u>Thursday</u> from 2.30 pm to assist any parents with any queries no appointments needed.
- **PHONES IN SCHOOL: Years 3 6 -** Please remember that children are no longer permitted to bring smart phones into school. Please ensure any device you buy your child is **not** a smart phone.
- **WATER BOTTLES**: Please remember to send your child to school with a **plastic water** bottle showing their name and not the metal variety.
- **ATTENDANCE:** We would like all parents to know that our target for school attendance remains at **96%**. Please report your child's absence from school before **9.30am** by telephoning 020 88075335 (Select Option 1 for Attendance) and advise us of the reason for your child's absence
