WHAT TO DO IF A CHILD DISCLOSES TO YOU

A child may confide in **ANY MEMBER** of the school community. It is your duty to listen, please remember the following:

- ⇒ Yours is a listening role, so do not interrupt if the child is freely recalling a significant event;
- ⇒ If you need to ask a question to clarify what the child is saying, make sure it is an **OPEN QUESTION** and you are not making suggestions or putting words in the child's mouth.
- ⇒ Do not interview the child!
- ⇒ Make a note of the discussion on **CPOMS promptly** and alert a member of the designated team shown on this card.
- ⇒ Remember you can never promise to 'keep a secret'.
- ⇒ Do not discuss the issue with parents/carers; refer to SLT if they request any information.
