#### Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to the summer term – we hope you all had a good break and the children are returning ready and eager to learn. Hopefully the weather will be good and we can provide lots of opportunities for the children to learn outdoors to support their academic, personal, social and emotional development.

**KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE: ROAD SAFETY & Parking in Wilbury Way/Weir Hall Road:** Please remember that road safety is the responsibility of <u>everyone</u> and we must ensure all our children are safe at all times. Please remember to park sensibly outside our school for the safety of all our children and **DO NOT** stop on the mini roundabout to drop off your child as this is extremely dangerous. In consideration of our neighbours, please do not park across their driveways whether the car is there or not. If they have a dropped kerb you could be fined up to £250 if traffic wardens are in attendance and it is towed.

Please keep well away from the bus stop area as this is very dangerous for children boarding or leaving the buses.

**ADVANCE NOTICE:** This term we are planning to hold a lockdown rehearsal with all classes – this is a just in case it is ever needed for example in the event of a gas leak or chemical spill on or outside of the premises. All children will take part and be asked to stay in doors/outdoors for the length of the lockdown (20mins) so please explain this to them so they are not alarmed. We will advise you when it has taken place. We have installed loud outdoor alarm sirens in our three playgrounds, which you may have heard being tested recently.

**PROPERTY IN SCHOOL**: Please be aware that we cannot accept any responsibility for children's property left on school premises. If your child leaves a bike or a scooter in the racks in school you <u>must</u> provide a secure lock for it. Some have gone missing lately which is very upsetting for the children. **TERRIFIC TWOS – paid places:** We are able to offer places in TWOS at £20 per session for parents who are not eligible for funding. This would be for five 3-hour sessions per week, mornings or afternoons during term time.

#### **REMINDERS:**

- BULGARIAN SURGERY: Our Bulgarian family support worker will be available in the office each <u>Thursday</u> from 2.30 pm to assist any parents with any queries – no appointments needed.
- PHONES IN SCHOOL: Years 3 6 Please remember that children are no longer permitted to bring smart phones into school. Please ensure any device you buy your child is <u>not</u> a smart phone.
- **WATER BOTTLES**: Please remember to send your child to school with a **plastic water** bottle showing their name and not the metal variety.
- NUT ALLEGIES: We are a healthy eating school and several of our children have severe nut allergies. Please DO NOT send any child into school with nut products (peanut butter, nutella etc) or chocolates or biscuits and cakes containing nuts in the lunch boxes. Even the smell of these products can cause an allergic reaction to another child sitting nearby.
